

SUSPENDED LICENSE?

Your license may be suspended because of:

- 🚦 Failure to respond to a traffic ticket.
- 🚦 Alcohol and drug violations.
- 🚦 Vehicular homicide, assault, or criminal negligence.
- 🚦 Certain vehicular offenses, such as speed racing.
- 🚦 Failure to pay child support.

Your suspended New York State driver's license can be restored once you've served the full suspension period and satisfied any other requirements, such as:

- 🚦 Paying the suspension termination fee.
- 🚦 Paying any outstanding fines.
- 🚦 Fulfilling any other conditions mandated by the court.

KNOW YOUR IMPACT


In 2019, **220 people** in New York City were killed in motor vehicle collisions. **152** of them (nearly 70%) were pedestrians or cyclists.

Seatbelts save lives. Not wearing a seatbelt makes you **4 times** more likely to require hospitalization in the event of a crash.

Being struck by a car is **the leading cause of injury-related death** for **children** under 14, and the second leading cause for seniors.

Most traffic crashes occur at intersections. **Left turns** are especially dangerous; they injure pedestrians and cyclists at **3 times the rate** as right turns and are **twice as fatal**.

As the **speed** of a vehicle increases, the **risk of death** increases:



KNOW THE LAW

Vision Zero is an initiative from the Mayor's office that implements a number of safety improvements with the goal of eliminating traffic-related deaths. Under Vision Zero, the NYPD has enhanced its efforts to enforce laws on dangerous driving. The following violations are some of the most common and most dangerous:

Speeding

Speed matters! Speed limits are set based on scientific research on survival rates in the event of a crash. Note the posted limit and be sure to obey it.

Failure to Yield to Pedestrians

There are millions of pedestrians and cyclists cross the streets in NYC. Know that you have a responsibility behind the wheel. The law requires you to give pedestrians the right of way.

Signal Violations & Improper Turns

Your signals are how you communicate with other drivers. Failing to signal or changing your decision at the last second can cause a collision. Yield to oncoming traffic even if you have a green light.

Texting while Driving

Cell phone use while driving leads to 1.6 million crashes each year. Texting while driving causes 5 times as many accidents than drunk driving. No text is worth a life.

TAKE ACTION

You have a role to play in making our streets safer! What steps will you take?

Leave a few minutes earlier so you're not in a rush and don't feel the need to speed.

Look behind and use your right hand when opening the driver's side door to exit your car – this will allow you to see cars or cyclists that might be coming your way.

Leave a safe stopping distance between you and the car in front of you.

Keep your eyes peeled for pedestrians and cyclists and yield at all crosswalks.

Drinking? Call a cab, take the subway, or sleep at a friend's place.

Place your phone on "do not disturb" mode while driving to keep your focus where it should be – on the road.
